**Program/Project Management -** identifying key objectives and scope of a proposed program or project; garner needed resources and support, develop a realistic and thorough plan for achieving key objectives, implementing action plans, communicating with ministry leaders and participants, identifying and resolving barriers and challenges.

- Passion to connect relationally with and beyond current membership (e.g. attending school plays, games, special events, and conducting one-on-ones with youth)
- Participate in after-school program in partnership with Boys & Girls Club
- Create and promote special outreach events for youth and families• Participate in community events

#### ESSENTIAL PROGRAM FUNCTIONS

- Provide primary leadership and coordination for shared Middle and High School programs (weekly youth group, faith development and youth leadership)
- Communicate directly with families and staff about programs and events
- Provide timely promotion and follow-up communication of events/activities with photographs/ summaries/articles.
- Plan and lead retreats & summer trips
- Work with pastors and other lay leaders to carry out this ministry
