Pentecost/Confirmation/Bluegrass Festival Worship Sunday, May 19th, 10:00 am at Woodlake



Once again, we are receiving scam emails that appear to be from Pastor Korla, Pastor Eric, and LMT members. Please be aware that NO ONE from the church would EVER email a church member asking for secretive "favors," or to buy gift cards (other than the Walmart or Holiday gift cards to be specifically dropped off for the



Friendship Fund). If you receive an email like this, please delete it immediately, and, if you question the validity of an email, contact the church for clarification, either at 612-866-8471, or <u>office@hoplc.org</u>. If you can, it's also helpful to report the email as a phishing scam to your email provider.

**Friendship Fund-Day** Our House of Prayer Friendship Fund continues to provide gift cards to those in need for Holiday Gas Stations and WalMart (as these are the two retailers closest to us). But the need is far greater than our budgeted amount can provide. In 2023, the state of MN recorded 7.5 million food shelf visits, a more than 30% increase from 2022. 2023 also recorded an average of 447,000 residents a month enrolled in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) the highest number since 2013. We know we can't solve

this problem alone, but are hoping to show greater compassion to our neighbors and are asking your help. In addition to donations of gift cards, we will be using the loose offerings collected in worship on the 2nd Sunday of the month to buy additional gift cards through the Friendship Fund. Loose offerings are all amounts not in a giving envelope or otherwise designated. Whether you put \$1, \$100, \$1,000 into the offering plate, those loose offerings will be turned into gift cards that we can share with our neighbors who stop by asking for assistance. Enthusiasm measures our being alive and there is plenty of that here at Mount Olivet Adult Day Services.


Programming includes opportunities to hear a poem, sing a song, hug a friend, dance, and play a game; all in one glorious morning or afternoon!
