Recycling Q/A Follow Up: Thanks for all the great questions! See the recycling guide below for more information. Here's what we learned:

DO NOT PUT RECYCLING IN PLASTIC BAGS. PUT DIRECTLY IN BIN.

• HOP collects recycling in bags to transport to the dumpster then empties the bag.

PAPER

- Shiny mail? YES. Mail, magazines, phone books, receipts are recyclable.
- Shredded Paper? YES. Put in a paper bag and close it.
- Boxes need to be flattened YES. [Pizza boxes are NOT recyclable, they are organic/compost).

PLASTICS

- Which numbers are recyclable? Plastic containers have a number in a triangle stamped on the bottom: #1, #2, #5 = YES; black plastic, #6 = NO
- HOP clear punch cups? YES (#1)
- Saran wrap / plastic bags? NO
- Soap pumps? NO [Soap containers, YES]

GLASS

- Jar/bottle covers? NO
- Household glass (e.g.) drinking glasses, cookware, windows? NO
